# Program Information

Most tuition-based preschools classrooms in Pattonville are half-day programs offered either mornings (AM) or afternoons (PM). Children must be 3 years old by July 31, 2015, to be enrolled in preschool. Children eligible for Kindergarten attendance in the fall of 2016 attend the PM preschool classes and full day at Bridgeway or the Learning Center. Younger children are enrolled in the AM preschool classes or full day at Bridgeway and the Learning Center. Preschool classes are available at the following locations:

**Bridgeway Elementary-Full Day Only**  
**Learning Center**  
**Parkwood Elementary**  
**Remington Traditional**  
**Rose Acres Elementary**

Preschool classes are available on a 2-half day, 4-half day or 5 full-day per week basis. The classes are as follows:

2-days/wk – M/W or T/Th – AM or PM

4-days/wk – M/T/W/Th – AM or PM

5-days/wk M/T/W/Th/F – Full Day-Learning Center & Bridgeway only

We also offer before and after school care at Bridgeway and the full day classroom at the Learning Center for an additional fee of \$3 per session.

There is a \$50.00 registration fee due with the completed application.

The annual fees for the 2015-2016 school year, which, can be paid in 10 installments, are as follows:

## Items required before a child can be enrolled for preschool:

A completed application, immunization record, birth certificate, & Proof of Residency. For **Proof of Residency**, two documents are required to provide proof that you reside in Pattonville, 1) a mortgage statement or signed, up-to-date lease **AND** 2) an unpaid utility bill or real estate tax bill. **If you reside with someone else in the district, please contact the Special Services office at 314-213-8090 to complete residency verification forms.** Students may enroll without Proof of Residency, but will be required to pay non-resident tuition rates. **Pattonville resident students will have priority over non-resident students.**

Music/Outside - approx. 25 mins.

Teacher/Child Small Group Time - approx. 45 mins.

Preparation for dismissal

All preschool students participate in developmentally appropriate activities throughout the day. During these activities, Early Childhood/Early Childhood Special Education teachers guide the education of your children.

## CURRICULUM

Pattonville Early Childhood board approved curriculum is based on a constructivist approach to learning. This approach emphasizes children learning through self-exploration, play, and hands-on activities. Activities are suited to children's ages and abilities and address all areas of development including: pre-academics, intellectual, language, social, emotional, physical and creativity. Each child will be assessed three times per school year and issued a progress report.

## TEACHING PHILOSOPHY

Our classrooms provide a place where each child can learn at his/her own pace in a non-competitive, non-threatening, positive, nurturing environment in which learning is fun. Children are learning in natural ways with teachers who provide understanding, enthusiasm, and patience.
